

## How to Add a Reciprocal Link from Your Web Site to [www.WomensPixels.com](http://www.WomensPixels.com)

1. You must have a software program that allows you to edit html code. If you do not have such a program or know how to use it, then ask your Web Master to include the link. Please use the following line of text on your web page to accompany the link:

**Connecting a worldwide community of women: [www.WomensPixels.com](http://www.WomensPixels.com)**

2. Many web sites have a "Links" or "Resources" page as one of the pages in the site. This is the logical place to include a link to [www.WomensPixels.com](http://www.WomensPixels.com). If your web site does not have a "Links" or "Resources" page, then you may want to include the link on your "Contact" page, or your Home page.

3. Copy and paste the following text below on the page you have chosen to place the link:

**Connecting a worldwide community of women: [www.WomensPixels.com](http://www.WomensPixels.com)**

4. In your html code, insert the following line of code in the appropriate location:  
`<a href="http://www.WomensPixels.com" target="_blank">www.WomensPixels.com</a>`

The resulting html code will look something like this:

```
<font color="#000000" size="2" face="Arial, Helvetica, sans-serif"><strong>Connecting  
a worldwide community of women, visit: </strong><a href="http://www.WomensPixels.com"  
target="_blank">www.WomensPixels.com</a></font>
```

5. Save your page and upload the page to your web site hosting server.
6. Open a web browser.
7. Enter the URL of your web site in the address window.
8. Go to the page where you have included the link to [www.WomensPixels.com](http://www.WomensPixels.com)
9. Test the link that you inserted to insure that it opens the WomensPixels web site.
10. Send an email to [Advertisers@WomensPixels.com](mailto:Advertisers@WomensPixels.com) to verify that you have included a reciprocal link to WomensPixels.com on your web site.
11. If you do not know how to add a link to your site, email us with your URL, user name and password, along with the page that you would like the link to be on.
